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QUESTION NO: 1

An organization publishes a SaaS application through Workspace ONE Access. Only members of the Sales directory group must see and launch the application in Intelligent Hub. Access must be removed automatically when a user leaves the directory group.

A Workspace ONE UEM Smart Group is used for UEM resource assignments and does not control Workspace ONE Access SaaS application entitlement.

QUESTION NO: 2

An application must be assigned to all users in the Finance directory group. New members of the directory group must receive the application automatically, and each user must receive the application on all of their enrolled devices.

Which assignment target should the administrator create?

- A. A Smart Group with the Finance user group criterion
- B. A device tag assigned to currently enrolled Finance devices
- C. An organization group containing the Finance administrators
- D. A static list of Finance device serial numbers

ANSWER: A

Explanation:

A **Smart Group** that uses the Finance user group as a criterion dynamically targets all enrolled devices associated with users in that directory group. Membership is updated as directory group membership changes. A device tag targets individual tagged devices, while an organization group or a static device list does not provide the required user-group-based dynamic assignment.
